








Purpose

Early Childhood Education Indicators



The Caring Homes Initiative provides technical assistance and capacity building for small businesses within the home-based childcare industry. With a Hispanic population of 83% in El Paso and more than 96% of childcare workers identifying as female, these efforts are expected to impact BIPOC small business owners.

Childcare desert is identified through zip codes, if the number of children under age 6 with working parents is three times greater than the licensed capacity of childcare providers in the area. 48% of El Paso residents live in areas deemed childcare deserts, where the number of children under age 6 with working parents is three times greater than the licensed capacity of childcare providers in the area.






United Way of El Paso County

Workforce Solutions Borderplex Child Care Services assists entrepreneurs in becoming childcare providers by offering opportunities such as growing a business, establishing a safe, secure, and nurturing environment, Texas Rising Star Certification, and becoming part of the Child Care Services subsidies program.





2. Business Development


Business Coaching

Business coaching is a form of professional development that aims to improve the performance of individuals and teams in a business setting. It involves working with a Technical Assistant who provides guidance, feedback, and support to help enrolled childcare providers, and individuals, identify and achieve their goals.

Business coaching can cover various topics, including leadership development, business accounts, time management, and strategic planning. It can be particularly helpful for individuals looking to grow their careers or businesses looking to improve their overall performance.



Project Vida Technical Assistant offers support for qualifying micro-business owners to help start, stabilize, and/or grow a business of 5 or fewer participants with 51% low or moderate-income members in which the owner works full time.



Technical Assistant

Technical Assistant's responsibilities include paperwork, report preparation, correspondence handling, managing databases, and information flow, and providing prompt technical assistance whenever necessary.

Technical assistance toward profitability includes but is not limited to business start-ups, licensing, permitting, accounting, business plans, marketing, preparing for loan applications, seminars, and workshops by knowledgeable professionals.



Business Plan



Quality childcare is essential for families and childcare providers alike. By prioritizing quality care, it can be ensured that children have the best possible start in life and that childcare businesses thrive.






Texas Rising Star

Texas Rising Star system offers high-quality child care and early learning programs in Texas. This program uses a rigorous approach to assess and improve quality in early learning programs, going above and beyond the minimum standards required by the CCR.

Programs that participate in Texas Rising Star are assigned a score based on a set of defined program standards and engage in continuous quality improvement. The program offers support to encourage participation and improve quality, including training, technical assistance, mentoring, and peer-learning opportunities. Finally, financial incentives are available to help childcare businesses improve learning environments, attain higher scores, and sustain long-term quality.





Child Care Operational Levels

Childcare providers are categorized into three operational levels based on their experience and accreditations.

The main objective is to become a licensed childcare home eventually. To qualify as a TRS site, a provider must meet the minimum requirement of being a registered or licensed childcare home.

Listed Home

Can care for up to three children and does not need to meet any minimum requirements. All the City of El Paso requires for listed homes are background checks.

Registered Home

The Provider must have a high school diploma or equivalent certification. Additionally, they must complete CPR, first aid, and child development courses.

The home must also have smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, a fire extinguisher, and a first aid kit. Providers must undergo background checks.



Licensed Child Care Home

The Provider must have a high school diploma or equivalent certification. Additionally, they must complete CPR, first aid, and child development courses. The home must also have smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, a fire extinguisher, and a first aid kit. Providers must undergo background checks.



Continued Learning

It's crucial for anyone providing childcare to stay informed on the latest developments in child development, engaging in continuing professional development can provide valuable insights into the unique needs of the children under your care.

- Increase the quality of childcare in a home daycare setting.




Program Structure & Activity Calendar







Setup Structure & Scalability of Room Setup

Setting up the structure and scalability of the room in your home daycare is essential. Having a wellorganized and structured space helps with the children's attention.

- Five learning centers that include but are not limited to reading, manipulatives, art, music, and dramatic play to increase the child's development domains.
- A scalable setup accommodates more children as the daycare grows.
- Provides a safe, nurturing, and stimulating environment for the children.











As a daycare provider, having ageappropriate learning materials and toys for the children in your care is important.

Age-appropriate learning materials

• Provide toys and materials that are appropriate for their age and skill level.

• Age-appropriate materials also help prevent frustration and boredom, leading to behavioral issues and other problems.



Safety Protocol & Regulatory Compliance



It is crucial to have safety protocols in place to ensure the well-being of the children under care. Safety protocols help maintain a safe environment for the children.

Safety protocols allow accidents and injuries to be prevented and responded to rapidly and effectively in emergencies. It helps you maintain high standards of care and provides peace of mind to parents. Regulatory guidelines can create a safe, nurturing, and stimulating environment that promotes children's growth and development.







Parent Communication & Engagement

Childcare providers must establish an open line of communication with the parents of the children they care for:

Staff Training

Ensuring that each assistant has undergone a thorough background check before working with children is essential.
